

"**Guilty, but going to heaven."**
This is usually because he thinks that God
is "good," and that He will, therefore,
overlook sin in his case. Point out that if a
judge in a criminal case has a guilty
murderer standing before him, the judge,
if he is a good man, can't just let him go.
Then tenderly tell him he has already
admitted to you that he has lied, stolen,
and committed adultery in his heart, and
that God gave him a conscience so that
he would know right from wrong. His
conscience and the conviction of the Holy
Spirit will do the rest.

-- Jesus is THE Christ, not "a christ" - Matt. 16:16; Acts 5:42, 17:3; 1 John 2:22

The REAL Jesus

There is "another Jesus" that is not the REAL Jesus of the Bible (2 Cor. 11:4). Salvation can only take place only through faith in the REAL Jesus. Faith in "another Jesus" cannot save anyone. So how can you tell if you have the REAL Jesus?

The Jesus of the Bible...

-- is prayed to - Acts 7:55-60; Psalm 116:4 and Zech. 13:9 with 1 Cor. 1:1-2
-- is worshiped - Matt. 2:2, 11; 14:33; 28:9; John 9:35-38; Heb. 1:6
-- is called God - John 20:28; Heb. 1:8; Isa. 9:6
-- is the ONLY way to God - John 14:6; Acts 4:12
-- did not come to bring peace, but a sword - Matt. 10:34
-- tells us to fear God - Matt. 10:28
-- tells us that the world will hate us - John 15:18-19, 17:14
-- tells us Christians can expect to suffer - Matt. 5:45; John 16:33; Heb. 11:35-38; 1 Pet. 4:12; 1 John 3:13
-- commands us share the gospel - Matt. 28:19-20; Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8

Helpful scriptures when talking to...

FALSE CONVERTS

-- did you know the Lord? - John 17:3
-- fornicators, adulterers, and homosexuals will not enter Kingdom - 1 Cor. 6:9-10
-- some claim to know God, but by their actions they deny Him - Titus 1:16
-- without holiness, no one will see the Lord - Heb. 12:14
-- examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith - 2 Cor. 13:5
-- children of God vs. children of the devil - 1 John 3:10

SELF-RIGHTEOUS PEOPLE

-- there is no one who is good - Psalm 14:3, 53:3; Matt. 19:17; Mark 10:18; Luke 18:19; Romans 3:12
-- everyone who is proud (arrogant) is an abomination to the Lord - Proverbs 16:5

MORMONS

-- Satan often masquerades as an "angel

of light" - 2 Cor. 11:14
-- there is only one God, not many - Isa. 43:10-11; 44:6; 45:5-6, 21b-22
-- all other "gods" the Bible talks about are idols - 1 Chron. 16:26; Exodus 20:3, 23

-- the God of the Bible created the entire universe - Gen. 1:16; Ps. 8:3; Jer. 31:35
-- Jehovah (translated as "LORD" in all caps) and Elohim (translated as "God") are the same being - Deut. 4:35; 1 Kings 8:60; Psalm 100:2.

JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES

-- the Jesus of the Bible cannot be another "god" because God says there is only ONE - Isa. 43:10-11
-- the Jesus of the Bible cannot be an angel, he is contrasted against the angels - Heb. 1:3-8
-- Jesus is not a creation, but the Creator... the word "other" has been inserted four times in this passage of the JW "bible" - Col. 1:16-17

Helpful scriptures when going through the Law...

9. Ever told a lie?

God says "...all liars, shall have their part in the lake of fire..." Revelation 21:8

7. Ever looked with lust?

Jesus said that lust is "adultery of the heart" (Matthew 5:28) - God says that no adulterers "...shall inherit the kingdom of God." 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

8. Ever stolen something?

God says, "No thieves... shall inherit the kingdom of God." 1 Corinthians 6:10

3. Ever used God's name as a cuss word? (Example "Oh my G-d!")

God says, "he that blasphemes the name of the LORD, shall surely be put to death..." Leviticus 24:16 and "every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment." Matt. 12:36

6. Ever hated anyone?

Hatred is the same as murder in God's eyes (1 John 3:15) - God says, "...murderers... shall have their part in the lake of fire..." Revelation 21:8

2. Do you have your own views on God?

Idolity of the imagination is the oldest sin in the Book, "these men have set up their idols in their heart..." Ezek. 14:3. God says that no idoliters "...shall inherit the kingdom of God." 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

10. Ever been greedy?

God says that he actually hates (abhors) "the covetous"; Psalm 10:3, and of those who are covetous (greedy) he says, "they which commit such things are worthy of death," Rom 1:29-32. Also see 1 Tim. 6:10.

5. Ever dishonored your parents?

God says, "he that curseth his father, or his mother, shall surely be put to death..." Ex. 21:17 and "rebellion is as the sin of

witchcraft" - 1 Samuel 15:23

1. Ever broken the first commandment?

"You shall have no other gods before me." That means that we should love God with all of our heart, mind, soul and strength. The Bible tells us that no one has kept this commandment (Psalm 14:2-3).

4. Ever done work on the Sabbath?

God said that anyone who did work on the Sabbath, "shall be put to death" - Ex. 35:2 Num. 15:32-36 tells of a man who merely picked up some sticks on the Sabbath, God said that he must be stoned to death.
